Chapter 2

Preparing For the Installation

Before you start installing Touch Terminal, read the following instructions.

- HiFive Series do not support PCI slot.
- Do not insert or remove any device or component from the HiFive Series while the power is turned on.
- If using HiFive Series in a dusty environment, clean the Touch Terminal regularly.
- Only USB devices are Hot Swap capable. Be sure to turn off the power of the touch terminal and the device before making any connection or disconnection.
- The spill proof design of HiFive Series conforms to IP65 standard (Front panel only).
- A bug may be found when installing Windows 2000 from a USB CDROM. When this occurs, please go to the Microsoft website at http://support.microsoft.com/kb/838921 and find the solution.
- Always seek the help of authorized service personnel in disassembling the terminal. The manufacturer will not be held responsible in the event of damage caused by an unauthorized person.
- Before installation or disassembling of the terminal, ensure that the power is turned off. Otherwise, electric shock may occur and may void the warranty.
- For systems preloaded with WEPOS/POSReady/Windows Embedded on the HDD (O/S pre-installed as an option), the manufacturer provides an optional recovery DVD with the preloaded operating system delivered with the Touch Terminal. The System Integrator shall take care of software restoration after an OS recovery. A manufacturer-supplied USB interface COMBO drive will be required for such action. Other brands of COMBO drive may require a specific driver different from what is supported in the recovery DVD. Please use the recovery DVD for rescue operation only. Using it otherwise may wipe out whatever is stored in the HDD. All upgrade device drivers needed for manual installation are available in the subfolder "\drivers" in the OS recovered HDD. Then follow the instructions from your system integrator for software recovery.
- For SoC limitation, the G-615S is required to install at least one DDR3 memory module before booting up the operating system. Be sure to install it in the DDR3 channel 1 socket.


Hardware Installation

Adjusting the System Stand (FLEX Type)

CAUTION:

Never open the unit unless it is in the lowest horizontal position. Otherwise, system components may be damaged.


- 1. Place the Touch Terminal on a stable surface and carefully lift the LCD panel.
- 2. Support the stand firmly with one hand while pushing the back of the LCD panel backwards with the other hand.



NOTE:

- Carefully tilt the unit backwards, some force is required.
- Lift the head to the 1st detent where the screen will lock in the 30-degree position. Then the 2nd detent will lock in 60-degree position.

3. Flip the LCD panel around to face outward.




NOTE:

- Because the stand joints are tight, you might need to exert someforce to maneuver the Terminal.
- Make sure always rotate around the head to the position "a" before adjusting the upper hinge.


Adjusting the System Stand (NANO Type)

Extend the kickstand and place the Touch Terminal on the stable surface.



Installing the Power Cord, Power Adapter, and Network Cable

- 1. Place the Touch Terminal on a soft and flat surface, with the LCD panel facing down. Then push the stand upwards (a) for easy access to the cable compartment cover.
- 2. Remove the cable compartment cover (b).
- 3. Route the power adapter and the network cable through the cable compartment. (c)
- 4. Connect the network cable to the LAN port. Then connect the power adapter to the DC IN jack. (d)
- 5. Use the cable clip to secure the power adapter in place. (e)
- 6. Align and install the cable compartment cover. (b)
- 7. Connect the power adapter to the power cord. Then plug the other end of the power cord to an electrical outlet. (f)
- 8. Connect the network cable to connect to a hub or switch. (f)



Installing the Customer Display (Optional)





- 9. Align and install the customer display into its slot on the stand. (h)
- 10. Secure the customer display to the Touch Terminal using the two screws. (i)
- 11. Align and install the customer display compartment cover. (f)
- Connect the customer display cable to one of the COM ports on the Touch Terminal. (j)
- 13. Replace the I/O port cover.



LITE Stand Type

- 1. Place the Touch Terminal on a soft and flat surface, with the LCD panel facing down.
- 2. Remove the four screws securing the stand to the Touch Terminal. (a)
- 3. Remove the stand. (b)
- 4. Detach the I/O port cover. (c)
- Align and place the customer display on the rear of the Touch Terminal. (d)
- 6. Place the stand on the top of the customer display bracket. (b)
- 7. Route the customer display cable as shown in the illustration. (e)
- Connect the customer display cable to one of the COM ports on the Touch Terminal. (f)
- 9. Replace the I/O port cover.
- Secure the stand and customer display bracket to the Touch Terminal with the four screws. (a)




Installing the Secondary LCD Display (Optional)

- 8. Align and install the secondary LCD display into its slot on the stand. (g)
- Secure the secondary LCD display to the Touch Terminal with the two screws. (h)
- 10. Align and install the cable compartment cover. (e)
- Connect the secondary LCD display USB Y-cable to the USB ports on Touch Terminal. (i)



Installing the Magnetic Stripe Reader (MSR) (Optional)



- 1. Remove the MSR module compartment cover. (a)
- 2. Firmly connect the MSR connector into the slot inside the compartment. (b)
- 3. Remove the two screws from the compartment. (c)
- 4. Align and install the MSR module onto its compartment. (d)
- 5. Secure the MSR module to the Touch Terminal with the two screws. (e)



Installing the VESA Mount (Optional)

- 1. Align and install the mount bracket on the back of the Touch Terminal. (a)
- 2. Secure the mount bracket to the Touch Terminal with the four screws. (b)
- Drill four small holes on the mounting location and insert the plastic washers into the holes.
 (c)
- 4. Align by the screw holes and then install the wall bracket on the wall. (d)
- 5. Secure the wall bracket to the wall with the four supplied screws. (e)
- 6. Align and hook the Touch Terminal to the wall bracket, and then push down to secure it into place. (f)



Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Question 1: How do I clear CMOS?

Answer: To clear CMOS, do the following:

- 1. Turn off the power and pull out the power cord.
- 2. Remove the battery from the **BAT1** connector about 15 seconds and then restore.

Chapter 4

- 3. Switch on the power again. First trigger is pre-boot for CMOS backfill. Second trigger is normal booting.
- 4. Press F2 to enter the CMOS setting and load the optimized defaults.
- 5. Save the changes and reboot the system.
